

ANNEX A: CONSENT TO DOPING CONTROL

I understand that Department of the Army (herein referred to as the "LOC"), has organized the CISM Wrestling World Championships (the "Event"), to be held in New Jersey on October 3-6, 2014, an USA Wrestling and CISM Sanctioned event. I understand that the LOC has contracted with the United States Anti-Doping Agency ("USADA") to conduct doping control services prior to and at the Event, including drug testing, test results management, adjudication of disputes involving anti-doping rule violations, processing Therapeutic Use Exemption ("TUE") applications, and providing educational information for Event participants. I understand and agree that as a participant in the Event, I will be subject to doping control conducted by USADA and that the World Anti-Doping Code ("Code") and the USADA Protocol for Olympic and Paralympic Movement Testing and its Annexes ("USADA Protocol"), apply to me and that I am required to abide by all such rules. I understand that I may be required to provide urine or blood (or any combination thereof) at the Event and I agree to submit to sample collection immediately upon notification that I have been selected for testing. I understand that it is my responsibility to know and understand all anti-doping rules applicable to me prior to signing this consent including the requirement to obtain a TUE from USADA prior to using a Prohibited Substance or Prohibited Method. I am also aware that I may find information regarding Prohibited Substances and Methods and TUE applications online by visiting: www.usada.org/misc/drug_information.aspx

I understand that significant penalties exist for any anti-doping rule violation and that such violations may be established through any reliable means including, but not limited to, drug testing, admissions, third-party testimony, and circumstantial evidence. If I am charged with an anti-doping rule violation I agree that my case will be administered in accordance with the USADA Protocol and the anti-doping rules of my sport's International Federation (if applicable), which have implemented mandatory provisions of the Code; I agree that arbitration under the terms of the rules is my sole and exclusive legal recourse and the only potential remedy for, and sole means of addressing, any charge of doping or eligibility issues arising in connection with any matter related to the collection, transport, and analysis of my sample, or the reporting or communication of drug testing information or doping control results. I hereby waive and release any other right, remedy, claim or cause of action involving USADA, the LOC, or any other party relating to doping control and/or the handling, analysis and reporting of my sample(s) or the administration of any potential or actual anti-doping rule violation. In the event that I am found to be in violation of USADA rules and I challenge the results, I am responsible for any and all costs associated with the challenge.
