ACCOMMODATIONS & TRAVEL

All expenses and reservations for lodging, travel to and from this competition, local transportation, etc. are the responsibility of the competitor.

SAFETY AND MEDICAL

All firearms safety practices will be observed. Failure to obey safety rules is cause for disqualification. Any medical emergency should be reported to the NCOIC, International Rifle Section, range personnel, or the Match Director.

RANGES

- a. Headquarters for all events will be located at the Pool and Phillips ranges.
- b. 50M will be held on Pool Outdoor Range.
- c. 10M will be held on Pool Indoor Range.
- d. 25M will be held on Phillips range.

PARKING

Parking at the Fort Benning ranges will be allowed only in designated parking areas.

SECURITY

Competitors are responsible for the security and storage of their personal items and equipment. DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING ON THE RANGE OVERNIGHT.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The consumption of alcoholic beverages on Fort Benning ranges is prohibited.

COMPETITOR ELEGIBILITY

All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting. Interservice Awards will be restricted to those members who are in the Active Military, National Guard, Reserve, and undergraduates of the Service Academies.

ENTRY/REGISTRATION

There will not be any separate match fees for the Interservice Match as it is run concurrently with the USAS Nationals, however you will have to register and pay USAS to enter the Nationals.

CATEGORIES/CLASSIFICATION

Competitors in the Interservice Match will compete in the OPEN category.

SQUADDING

All events will be squadded and start lists will be posted at the entry office and on each range. Only the Classification Officer will do changes in squadding for reasons other than target failures.

RULES

Current USA Shooting Rules govern this competition. Special circumstances may require the issuance of modifications to firing conditions. Match Director's Bulletins will be posted at the match headquarters and all ranges to notify shooters and officials of any such modifications.

No one other than authorized personnel is to operate the electronic target controls and equipment.

COMPETITORS RESPONSIBILTY

It is the competitor's responsibility to fire the prescribed number of shots on the correct targets. Penalties will be assessed according to the current USA Shooting Rules. It shall be the competitor's responsibility to immediately inform the range officer of any hits on incorrect targets.

EQUIPMENT AND AMMUNITION

Equipment will be spot checked at this competition. All arms, ammunition, clothing and equipment must comply with current USA Shooting Rules and are subject to re-inspection at any time by officials.

The range will supply shooting mats. Personal mats may be used provided they meet USA Shooting Rules.

Competitors must provide their own ammunition. All ammunition must conform to current USA Shooting Rules.
